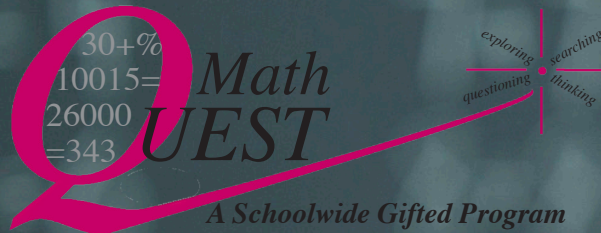


# Math QUEST Informational Meeting

Math QUEST is an accelerated math program for students who are capable of working at two grades or more beyond their current placement. Grade 3 and 4 Math QUEST screening will take place at all elementary schools between March 13th – 24th, 2018. The assessment results are one part of the criteria used for identification for those students who demonstrate the propensity for an accelerated pace for learning with a demanding curriculum.

Math QUEST students interpret ideas through mathematical discourse and inquiry into numbers, thoughts, words, patterns, and theory to build and discover meaning through standards, essential understandings, knowledge, skills, and processes.

Students will be actively engaged using concrete materials and technologies for understanding of mathematical concepts or relations. Problem-solving is a continuous process of integration in the curriculum with a specialized vocabulary and language pattern critical to the student's knowledge. Students will think deeply and apply a wide variety of skills and strategies for solving a myriad of problem types. The depth and breadth of content are critical components in developing habits of mind that are essential to student success.
